The Information Governance Team have carried out an assessment of your request. Following this exercise I can confirm that the Council considers that your request meets the threshold established by the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) to be considered manifestly unreasonable in accordance with Regulation 12(4)(b). Therefore we are not obliged to respond.

In arriving at this decision we have considered the context and history of your previous communication with the Council on matters relating to health and safety. We feel that this latest request is an extension of that correspondence. As explained in previous communication with you we feel that the burden of complying with your request is disproportionate to the value of the request.

Devon County Council are mindful of the public interest of openness and transparency, however in this instance we feel that the public interest is best served in withholding this information from disclosure at this time.

I hope this clarifies the position of Devon County Council.
